We arrived at the Lodge May 27, 2006 to absolutely no ice. That's right the Lake was completely free of ice and had been for almost 2 weeks. After experiencing some of the latest ice outs in history in 2004 and 2002 this year was one of the earliest recorded. This was also only the second year we arrived at the Lodge with the aircraft on floats. Most years we arrive on wheels and land on the airstrip before the ice is off the lake.

The early spring made getting the camp ready to open very easy. Moving supplies and getting the airstrip ready for its annual inspection by CBR Technologies of Calgary was much easier than in years past.

2006 also saw the introduction of flexible dinner hours and a menu to order from. Gone are the days when you are forced to eat the same thing as everyone else.

Lindbergh's is all about choices and now you get to choose when and what you want to eat. If the fish are biting at 5:00pm no need to worry, stay an extra hour dinner will be prepared fresh for you when you return. Dinner is served each night from 6:30 to 8:30pm.

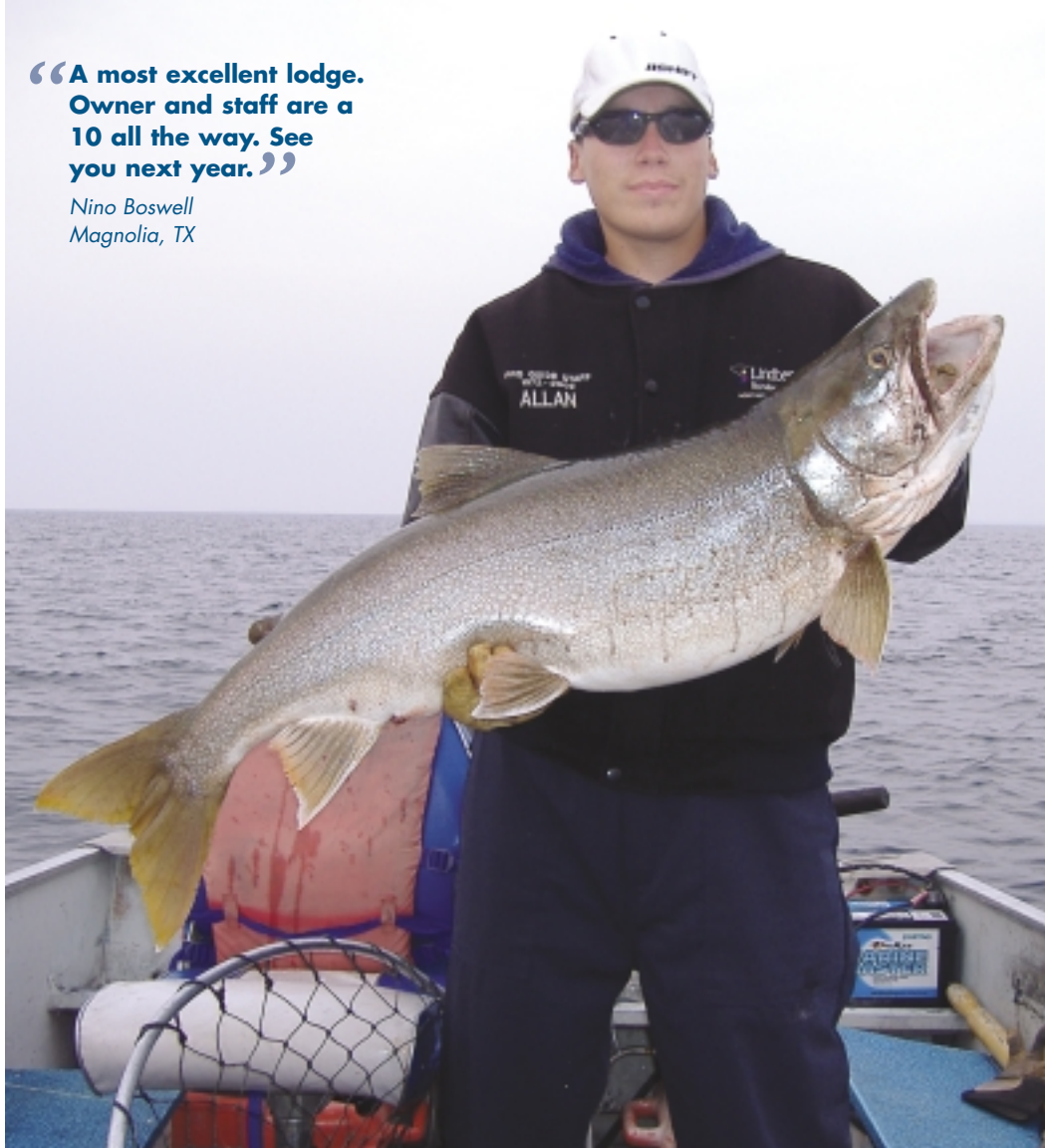

The 700 Club

The fishing is always great at Lindbergh's Reindeer Lake Lodge, some years are unbelievable and other years are just really good but over the years we have consistently produced more trophy Northern's per guest than any other lodge. Looking back through the records some fishermen really stand out and that created the idea for the 700 Club. To be a member you must catch and release over 700 inches of trophy Northern Pike.

This year Jeff Norris, of North Olmstead, OH, joined with a total trophy catch of 701.5 inches. In Jeff's catch were a 45.5", 46", 47.5", 2 x 48" and a 48.5". Jeff caught and released a total of 16 trophy Northern during his week stay with us.

Frank Gron from Menter, OH also joined the 700 Club in 2004 with a total of 760 inches of trophy Northern's. Frank caught and released 18 Northern's over 40"

In 2003 Keith Swanson of IN. caught and released 24 Northern's over 40" for a total 1,018 inches, Gord Lounsbury of St Catharines, ON had a total of 790 inches with 19 trophies and Bob Mehsikomer and his son Jason boated a whopping 2,715 inches of trophy Northern's. That was 65 Northern's over 40".

Howard Kalka joined the 700 Club in 2002 with a total catch of 857 inches and in 2001 Darren Shaffer joined with 710.5 inches, Leonard Kasprzak with 1013 inches and Curt Albrecht with 739.5 inches. Curt's total included 3, 48" Northern
